The most common reasons for referral to the Day Assessment Unit (DAU) are:

- Raised blood pressure
- Slow growth of your baby
- Patients on SGA pathway
- Observing your baby's fetal movements by CTG (increased surveillance)
- A review prior to your arranged induction
- Not enough fluid around your baby (Oligohydramnios) after your formal review by a clinician
- Twins/Triplets
- Turning breech babies (ECV)
- Iron Infusion
- Premature rupture of membrane (increased surveillance)
- Surveillance cholestasis or pregnancy (after formal review)

You may have been referred for another reason.

Please come to the Day Assessment Unit located within the Women's Assessment Unit on level 9 of Auckland City Hospital for your appointment on:

At this appointment you may have some of the following observations performed depending on the reason for your referral:

- Blood pressure checks
- CTG - monitoring of your baby's heart rate
- Urine test
- Blood tests
- Ultrasound examination of your pregnancy

You will be cared for by a midwife and may also be seen by a doctor.

The DAU is a room set up with 4 lazy boy chairs.

How to prepare for your visit to DAU:

1. Please have breakfast before attending your appointment and keep up your fluids.
2. Please bring this pamphlet with you, as it will serve as your appointment record.

After all the necessary observations have been completed you will be advised if and when you need to return for a subsequent appointment with DAU.

We will phone your Lead Maternity Carer (the midwife or doctor) to keep them informed of your plan.
