

Care guide for women entering women's Assessment Unit (WAU) or Labour and Birthing suite (LBS)

asked to contact LMC prior to coming to hospital and LMC to ascertain risk.

that if possible women should be clinically assessed at home prior to decision for admission.

No one should come to hospital unless there is a clinical need for admission

presenting directly to WAU or LBS SCREEN VIA INTERCOM PRIOR TO ENTRY – Follow current screening

epidemiological risk, suspect, probable or confirmed case definition AND needs assessment/admission

an a mask prior to coming to hospital and advise to wear it on entry or give woman a surgical mask
arrival and move to single room, close door. WAU Room 13 or LBS Room 1.
